



Fodder and Tipple Trail 2021

Ticket

The ticket costs £26.50 and includes all food and drink, a guided trail route and an artisan goody bag. You will be issued with receipt after booking and an e-ticket and trail guide closer to the event date.

Tickets are sold subject to the conditions below:

- The Fodder and Tipple trail takes place on one day only Saturday 25th September 2021 between 10am and 4pm
- Tickets are limited at this event.
- Advance booking is necessary due to numbers and catering on the day.
- Persons under 18 will not be served alcoholic drinks and must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Each premises has the right to do an ID check regarding alcoholic sales.
- Comfortable clothing and suitable walking shoes are recommended for this event.
- All participants must ensure they are fit and able to take part in the trail route if walking.
- We advise that all participants take care when walking the route in case of uneven, rough ground or wet, slippery mud.
- All participants are asked to stick to the trail route, respect the property and not trespass on private land.
- We will not refund the ticket if the weather is inclement
- Participants must wear masks when entering a business premise which has stipulated these measures are in place.
- If we sell out of tickets, we may stagger the timings but will be in touch with you about this closer to the date.
- The organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to any participant or to any third party during this even.

Special diets

A vegetarian alternative will be available if pre-ordered – we will send you an email when you have purchased your ticket to find out your requirements. We cannot cater to vegan or any other specific diets due to the planning of the event. Please confirm to us if you have any allergies.

Accessibility

Times

The trail starts and ends in Market Drayton from 10am, ending at 4pm. From 4pm there will be live music at the last stop, which is the Red Lion Inn at Joules Brewery.

Young Children and babies

Due to the nature of the length of the Fodder & Tipple Trail (approx. 5 miles), we recommend that children aged 12 and above are best suited to this event. Unfortunately the terrain is not be suitable for pushchair or very small children. All children must be accompanied by an adult. If you are carrying a small baby or child, they will be free of charge but food is for paying customers only.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome on this trail, but owners MUST keep their dogs on leads at all times.
