

Joule's Brewery Food and Drink Trail Terms and Conditions 2024

The ticket costs £25.50 and includes all food and drink. You will be issued with a ticket receipt at booking and the trail guide closer to the event date.

Tickets are sold subject to the conditions below:

- The Food and Drink Trail takes place on one day only Saturday 28th September 2024 between 9.30am and 4.30pm (venue opening times vary – please check on your ticket)
- Tickets are limited at this event
- Advance booking is necessary due to numbers and catering on the day
- Persons under 18 will not be served alcoholic drinks and must be accompanied by a responsible adult
- Each premises has the right to do an ID check regarding alcoholic sales
- Comfortable clothing and suitable walking shoes are recommended for this event
- All participants must ensure they are fit and able to take part in the trail route if walking
- We advise that all participants take care when walking the route in case of uneven, rough ground or wet, slippery surfaces
- All participants are asked to stick to the trail route, respect the property and not trespass on private land
- We will not refund the ticket if the weather is inclement
- Participants must adhere to any rules and regulations when entering a business premise which has stipulated these measures are in place such as masks for Covid
- If we sell out of tickets, we may stagger the timings but will be in touch with you about this closer to the date
- The organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to any participant or to any third party during this event

Special diets

A vegetarian alternative will be available if pre-ordered – we will send you an email when you have purchased your ticket to find out your requirements. We cannot cater to vegan or any other specific diets due to the planning of the event. Please confirm to us if you have any allergies.

Accessibility

The route may include some downhill sections, a road without a pavement, steps and some rough ground (at times) which may not be suitable for push or wheelchairs. However, if this is so, there will be an alternative route available which excludes the steep steps/downhill and road without pavement.

Some premises are extremely old (& listed) and do have steps at their entrance – when this occurs, the business owner will arrange for your taster to be brought out to you. Please email us if you would like to arrange this in advance or if you have any questions, gingerandspicefest@gmail.com.

Times

The trail starts and ends in Market Drayton from 9.30am, ending at 4.30pm. There is a gingerbread eating contest at 5pm and live music at 7pm both at the Red Lion at Joules Brewery.

Young Children and babies

Due to the nature of the length of the Fodder & Tipple Trail we recommend that children aged 14 and above could attend this event but will not be able to participate on the alcoholic drink taster courses. Unfortunately some of the terrain is not suitable for pushchair or very small children. All children must be accompanied by an adult. If you are carrying a small baby or child, they will be free of charge but food is for paying customers only.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome on this trail, but owners MUST keep their dogs on leads at all times. Some premises may not allow the dog into the building. Please check with the owners or staff on the day.
